

Mark Your Calendar for the Stonyford Rodeo

The annual PRCA rodeo is coming to Stonyford on May 3, 4, and 5, 2024. The rodeo excitement begins at 5 p.m. on Friday, May 3, and is an all-PRCA rodeo. On Saturday, the day starts with breakfast, in the fire hall, at 7 a.m. and last until 10 a.m., when the rodeo parade starts. The day's rodeo action starts at 1 p.m. and is a mix of PRCA and amateur events. The rodeo weekend ends on Sunday with breakfast, in the fire hall, from 7 to 10 a.m. Sunday's rodeo are all amateur events and starts at noon.

Two past-rodeo favorites from last year, announcer Kelley Kinney and barrelman JJ Harrison will return and a new trick rider, Piper Yule, will make her initial appearance. Piper Yule hales from Southern Alberta, Canada, and is a 5th generation cowgirl. She has won many Awards. They include 3X Canada Pro Rodeo Dress Act of the Year, 3X PRCA Top 5 Dress Act Nominee and PRCA National Finals Rodeo Opening Act. To learn more, visit her website at www.piperyule.com.

Rodeo tickets will soon be available for purchase on our website at www.stonyfordrodeo.com, and at the ticket-sale locations listed on the website. Get your tickets early and save money. Pre-rodeo sale tickets are \$15 for adults and \$7 for children. Tickets at the gate on rodeo day are \$20 for adults and \$10 for children.

There are no motels or hotels in Stonyford; however, camping is available at the rodeo grounds for \$30 per vehicle (cash only at the gate—no credit cards). There are also camping sites at two locations at the East Park Reservoir. The nearest location is 2 miles from the rodeo grounds and the other is 8 miles away.
