We're baack! The 78th Annual Stonyford Rodeo returns on the weekend of April 30 thru May 2, 2021

Mark your calendar for a fun-filled weekend in Stonyford. Following a year's absence because of the Pandemic--which broke a continuous run of 76 years--the professional rodeo will run on Friday, April 30, and Saturday, May 1, 2021. Amateur events will run on Sunday, May 2, 2021. The arena gates will open at 3 p.m. on Friday and the events will begin at 5 p.m. On Saturday, the gates will open at 10 a.m. and the events will kick off at 1 p.m. On Sunday, the gates will open at 10 a.m. and the amateur events will start at 12 noon.

You can count on seeing a top-flight professional rodeo on Friday and Saturday. You will see top-rated cowboys competing in bareback, saddle-bronc, and bull riding events. Cowboys will compete in team roping, tie-down roping, and steer wrestling; top-ranked women will compete in barrel racing and break-away roping. Additionally, funnyman J J Harrison will return as our clown and barrelman. J J worked our 2018 and 2019 rodeos. Announcer Don Jesser has retired, after working our rodeos for the past 28 years. We will be interviewing for his replacement. The Bridwell Rodeo Company will be supplying the stock, as they have in the past. We are keeping our rodeo on track and looking forward to a great rodeo weekend.
